Summer Reading

CHOICE BOARD

- Step 1: Read the assigned book for your grade level (see flyer: Summer Reading 2023)
- Step 2: Choose 1 project from the choice board below. (Projects may be completed by hand or digitally)
- Step 3: Turn in your summer reading project to your Language Arts teacher. Make sure your name is on it.

The summer reading project will count as a participation assignment for the first nine weeks. Your grade will be based on: literary understanding, required elements, and attention to detail.

Poetry

Write a poem (free verse, acrostic, repetition, etc.) that is inspired by the characters or events in the story. Include a title.

Lyrics

Write a song or rap that is inspired by the characters or events in the story. Include a title.

Book Review

In 3 paragraphs expain:
1.Summary of book
2.How you connected to
this book personally +
What did this book teach
you about life?
3. Would you recommend

this book? Why?

Comic Strip

Create a comic strip from an important scene using 6-8 slides. Include: captions, dialogue, + thought bubbles.

Story Elements

Create a booklet or PowerPoint explaining:

- 1. Setting
- 2. Characters
- 3. Plot
- 4. Conflict
- 5. Theme

Plot It

Create a plot mountain or rollercoaster:

- 1. Exposition
- 2. Rising Action
- 3. Climax
- Falling Action
- 5. Resolution

Movie Flyer

Design a movie flyer. If the book became a movie, what would the movie poster look like? Include catchy phrase.

Inside My Head

Choose 1 character.

Outline their head. Inside include: recurring thoughts; fears; strong memories; dreams; things they say; etc.; Include visuals + quotes
